After graduating from the University of California, Berkeley with honors in 1970, he obtained his J.D. in 1974 from the UC Hastings College of the Law in San Francisco. He is currently an Assistant Professor of Dental Jurisprudence at the Arthur A. Dugoni School of Dentistry in San Francisco and an Adjunct Faculty Professor at the University of California, San Francisco. As a trial attorney, he has been defending doctors for over 40 years and has presented risk management courses throughout the United States and Canada. He is an associate of the American Board of Trial Advocates. TOPIC	<p>Malpractice and Prevention - Avoiding the Legal Failures: Successful risk management is important for today's dental practitioner because "An ounce of prevention is better than a pound of cure".</p> <p>Responding to dental claims is inefficient. The doctor and staff spend time away from patient care and therefore production. Patient dissatisfaction has a negative effect on referrals from the other doctors as well as patients, particularly in this era of social media. This course will focus on the tools for claims prevention as well as discuss of:</p> <p>The new Standards for Records: When a disgruntled patient seeks legal counsel, the first thing the attorney will do before deciding on whether or not to take a case is to request a copy of the would be doctor's records. The content, quality and breath, and standards of care created by digital records will determine the direction of the case.</p> <p>The new Standards for Digital Dentistry: Automated RCT depth finders, microscopes, laser treatments, digital models and appliances, and cone beam CTs have or will change the standard of care, requiring consideration for their implementation as part of a risk management program.</p>
